1. 2007 ACT National Conference RFP: The board discussed the RFP that ACT National has released soliciting proposals to host the 2007 ACT National Conference. The board has been seriously considering submitting a proposal but has had concerns about new provisions related to chapter expectations and profit sharing. Houston may also be interested in submitting a bid, and Seattle may also be contender to host the conference in 2007.

After discussion, the board decided that RMACT will submit a letter to National indicating that the board would like to host the 2007 conference, but are not submitting a proposal. The letter will outline the board's concerns about profit sharing, and will highlight positive aspects about Denver and its likelihood for success as a host location.

Should ACT choose to move forward with another location for 2007, the board will develop a small regional conference. This will allow RMACT to showcase the positive transportation and land use changes in Denver over the past decade and to earn income for the chapter.
