- Two (2) \$1000 scholarships for the [ACT International Conference](#) in Chicago, IL (August 27-31)
- Two (2) \$750 scholarships for the [ACT/PIPTA Joint Conference](#) in Vancouver, WA (July 17-19)
- One (1) \$2500 scholarship for the 2012 [Leadership Academy](#) (begins January 2012)

The purpose of the RMACT Chapter is to provide a means through which members can share information about commuter transportation issues; and to enhance the professional development of its members. This funding is also available to help offset the costs of attending one of these RMACT/ACT sponsored events.

Eligibility:

1. Any current RMACT Chapter member may apply for a scholarship.
2. Scholarship applications are due by **Friday, May 19th 2011**.

Award Criteria:

1. The RMACT Board will review all applications and notify applicants as to the status of their application.
2. The number of scholarships awarded and the amount of each scholarship will be at the discretion of the RMACT Board.
3. Funds may be awarded to cover partial or total costs of the conference registration fee only. Hotel and flight reservations/payments are the responsibility of the attendee.
4. In order to extend the scholarship funds, priority will be given to applicants that provide matching funds.

Award Acceptance:

Awarded applicants will be notified by **Friday, May 20th 2011**. Applicants offered a scholarship must notify the President of RMACT of their intent to accept the scholarship no later than Wednesday, May 25th, 2011. Scholarship winners are required to submit an article to the RMACT newsletter regarding their experience.
